

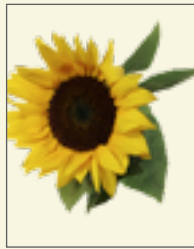

What can Nurse Practitioners help with?

- Ear infections
- Sore throats
- Coughs, colds and chest infections
- Sinusitis
- Skin rashes, Impetigo
- Urine infections
- Thrush
- Skin Infections
- Hay fever
- “Morning after pill”
- Contraception, queries and prescriptions
- Vaginal discharge
- Minor injuries
- Constipation
- Burns
- Diarrhoea / Vomiting
- Haemorrhoids
- Wounds

- Asthma
- Chronic Obstructive Airways Disease

Exclusions:

- Under one year of age
- Pregnant
- Severe chest pain or severe difficulty breathing
- Having convulsions
- Coughing / vomiting blood
- Sudden loss of sight
- Bleeding profusely from any orifice
